It is the dog days of summer, school is about

to start, and autumn is just around the corner. I hope you are having a great summer and looking forward to a break in the hot temperatures. Before you know it, winter will be here. It is time for members to begin signing up for trips on the 2015-16 Winter Trip Schedule. Your Club Trip Committee has been working since last spring pulling together a terrific trip schedule with a little bit of something for everyone.

To launch this year's ski trip season, your Club is hosting a Trip Sign-Up Event at First Tuesday, September 1, at Californos Back Deck starting at 6:00p.m. Trip Captains will be there to personally discuss their trips and answer any questions you may have.

All the information you need for trip signup is in this Slushboomer. Inside this issue are: trip flyers, application and sign-up instructions. Also included is the 2015-16 Winter Trip Schedule (inside the back page) that includes: destinations, dates, lodging, trip captains' contact information, and trip prices. Prices can vary with upgrades available for private bunks on bus trips, private beds on the Keystone and Winter Park trips, and fly/drive options on the Aspen, Keystone 1, Telluride (FSA), Steamboat, Taos, and Vail trips. In addition to our bus trips, we are offering an air trip to Park City, Utah (who would like to ride the new gondola?) Please see trip flyers inside this issue for more details about each trip as well as the various methods available to sign-up.

This year, bus transportation will be provided by Windstar Lines, Inc. with an assist from Village Tours for the Telluride FSA trips. Bus trips include transportation via sleeper-coach (tour bus) with 4 people per booth/2 per bunk or upgrade to 1 per bunk (private bunk) at additional cost. Standard shared bunk is an economical way for families and couples to travel. Single travelers and those who want more room may want to purchase a private bunk. We are finalizing our bus departure lo-

cation which will be provided by the trip captains to trip participants. As usual, beverages, snacks and evening meals are included in outbound and return trips. Beer in cans is the only alcoholic beverage allowed on the bus as no wine or whining permitted on the bus.

Within 5 days after sign up, you will receive an email from the Club confirming your status on the trip. Don't be left out in the cold as we expect our annual Presidents' snow dance to yield great results this season.

Remember, you must be a member of the Kansas City Ski Club to sign up for trips. If you haven't renewed your membership, please go to the website and renew now. If you don't remember your user name and password, just access that website, select "Forgot My Username/Password," and enter your email address and first name. You will receive pronto a new password. competition. about Racing can help to improve your technique for recreational skiing/boarding. Carving a turn at a predetermined spot (such as going around a race gate) means that you can carve a turn when the slope dictates (or when there is someone in your way). NASTAR is the amateur racing program you will find at most ski resorts. For a few bucks you can try your hand at racing. If you are interested and want to know more, ask any member of the Race Committee, or your trip captain if you are on a trip, and they can tell you where to find NASTAR and committee members can give you a tip. You can also ask the friendly people in the shack at the top of the NASTAR course; they are happy to give you instruction.

Of course, you can compete if you like! The KC Ski Club is a member of the Flatland Ski Association (FSA). The FSA is an organization of 9 clubs from the Midwest that race

against each other each year in January. This year the competition is in Telluride, Colorado. Check the ski trip schedule for details. The KC Ski Club needs all racers on deck this year to once again become number one. The other clubs brought stiff competition last year and we need to rise to the occasion.

The KC Ski Club also has a club race called the Kandahar. The Kandahar has been held at Snow Creek in February for the past couple of years. Because of waning participation and because of how busy Snow Creek has become, the committee will be looking into the future of Kandahar and where, or if, it will be held this upcoming season.

In order to do your best on the race course or in order to enjoy yourself on the slopes, you need to stay in shape year round. Here are some of the best exercises you can do in the summer:

Trailrunning—Dirtismoreforgiving on your knees than pavement and the twists and turns of a trail help to build balance and core muscles.

Biking – Whether mountain biking or road biking, the speed of biking can help you feel like you are skiing. A great aerobic exercise, it also has minimal impact on joints.

Hiking – Get out on the slopes during the summer. Hiking can be done solitary or in groups. It is good for leg muscles and communing with nature.

Stand-up Paddle Boarding – What a great core workout! On a flat lake, try a few yoga poses on the board to challenge yourself. Try to stay stable on the river with some mild rapids in order to really work those core muscles.

Yoga – Yoga is a great way to stretch all your muscles and still build your core. Yoga can be done anywhere from your living room to your office. You just need a few feet of space to do a few poses to keep your muscles energized all day long.

Helpful KCSC Definitions

The trip articles on the following pages use a lot of terms veteran club members should understand from years of experience; however, this year we have some new terms. As a public service, we offer these definitions:

Sign Up Definitions:

Trip Application: A paper Trip Application including the Risk Waiver must be completed and SIGNED by each individual trip participant (even if you signed up on the website). Also a parent/legal guardian must sign for a minor. Minors 16 and over must also sign their trip application.

Lodging Definitions:

Family Trip: Activities geared to families. Children must be five years or older. While trips are recommended for families, all members are welcome.

Minimum Occupancy (**M**): No one sleeps on the couch. In condos, example: Two people per bedroom. Hotel rooms are two per room. **Maximum Occupancy** (**X**): Four people in a hotel room or in condos, the maximum number for which the unit is designed.

Private Bed (B): Available on maximum occupancy trips only. Pay an additional fee to have a bed to yourself.

Ski-in/Ski-out (**S**): Slope side condominium accessible by skiing to or from the property.

Holiday (**H**): Trip is over a holiday.

Party(P): Trip includes an event hosted by the Trip Captain or lodging property.

Bus Trip Definition: Includes lodging, travel via sleeper motor coach, four per booth, two per bunk. Limited private bunks available for an additional fee. Single travelers and those who want more room may want to purchase private bunk. Bus trip includes dinner, beverages, and snacks on both the outbound and return trips. No smoking on the bus.

Bus Definitions:

Standard Shared Bunk: Two people on one side of a booth on the bus. Two people sharing a bunk on the bus approximately the width of a twin bed.

Private Bunk: Pay an additional fee to have one side of the booth to yourself and your own bunk. You may have one or two people sitting across from you in the booth. Single travelers and those who want more room may want to purchase private bunk.

Departure time: Air trips depart on the date indicated – departure times vary. Bus trips depart on the evening of the date indicated, generally between 5:30 p.m. and 6:30 p.m. You will need to arrive a half-hour prior to departure to load the bus. Your Trip Captain will advise you of the exact loading and departure times – DON'T BE LATE! If you are not there by departure time, the trip will leave without you. **Return time:** Return to KC early morning of the date indicated. Road and weather conditions can be a factor on all trip times and are not guaranteed. Air trip return times vary.

Bus baggage: ONE suitcase, ONE ski bag, ONE boot bag that will be stored under the bus. A <u>SMALL</u> tote bag, a blanket and pillow that will fit in a shared overhead compartment for use while on the bus.

Bus Etiquette: Sleep in the bunk you sit in. Alternate facing forward/backward when seated on the way out/back. Sleep with feet toward the driver. Sleep with the person you sit with. Alternate upper/lower bunk on the way out/back (unless otherwise mutually agreed upon). NO SMOKING on bus trips. No sunflower seeds. Canned beer is the only alcoholic beverage allowed on the bus. No wine (or Whining) on the bus. Be thoughtful of others who are sleeping whether you are a night owl or an early riser. See trip regulations for further details.

Fly/Drive Trip Definition: Includes lodging and on-trip activities. Does not include transportation.

Fly/Drive Early Arrival Option Definition: Purchase 1 additional night of lodging for an additional fee due at signup. Check into lodging the night before the bus arrives. NOTE: Your room may be used as a change room for bus participants upon arrival.

<u>Air Trip Definition:</u> Includes lodging, air transportation, and transfers.

Click on any of the upcoming meetings, events, and trips listed on the right side of the home page for more information. We want you to continue to receive the annual Slushboomer Trip issue and email updates from KCSC. Please help us by making sure we have your correct contact information – just login to your website profile and update your address, phone numbers, and email address.

- 1. *How do I get on the web-site?* Anyone can view the public side of the kcskiclub.org website, just enter kc-skiclub.org into your Internet browser.
- 2. How do I login to my account and see the member side of the website? Go to kcskiclub.org. Click on "Member Login" in the upper right corner. The Login screen will appear, enter your User Name and Password to get to the member part of the website.
- 3. How do I update my profile on the website with my new address, phone #s, or email address? Login to your account on the website. Click on your name in the upper right corner, then click on "Profile" in the drop down box. The "Member Profile" screen appears, find the "Personal Info" box. Click on "Contact Info." Enter any changes to your address, home phone #, phone #, and email address, and click the "Save" blue button at the bottom.

Also, please be sure to update the contact info for others on your membership. In the "Personal Info" box, click on "Additional Members in Your Account", then click on edit by each additional member on your membership. Enter any changes to address, home phone #, phone #, and email address, and click the "Save" blue button at the bottom.

- 4. How do I add my picture to the membership directory? Follow #2 and #3 above to login and go to the "Member Profile" screen. Click on "KC Ski Club Member Directory" in the "Personal Info" box. Scroll to the bottom of the page and look for a ? inside a box or your previous photo. Click on "Choose File" next to the box and select a picture from your hard drive. Click on the "Save" blue button.
- 5. What if I forgot my User Name or my Password? Go to keskielub.org. Click on "Member Login" in the upper right cor-

ner. The Login screen will appear, click on the "Forgot my UserName/Password" link just below the login box. Enter your email address and first name. Your User Name and Password will be emailed to you. If the website can't find you in the member list, you will see a box "Could not match your email address and first name..." Then send an email to membership@kcskiclub.org with your name, current email address, and phone number. They will update your email address on your profile, reset your password, and email you your user name and temporary password.

6. How do I find out more details about a KCSC event or trip? Login to your account on the website. There are two easy ways to get to a trip / event webpage with all the details: 1) Click on the event or trip in the list on the right side of the home page or "Trip Info" page. 2) Click on "Event Calendar" in the website menu on left side of the page. Click on the month in the upper corner to advance to the month until you get to the date for the event or trip. Click on the event/trip name.



- 7. This trip sounds like fun, how do I sign up for it online? Login to your account on the website and go to the detailed webpage for the trip. Click on the blue "Sign Up Now" button on the right side of the detailed trip webpage. Then follow the prompts to select your trip options, complete your registration, and pay your deposit. Note: Winter Trips don't open for online registration until after the September First Tuesday Sign Up event.
- 8. How do I make a payment for a trip online? Login to your account on the website. Click on your name in the upper right corner. Click on "\$ Payment Due" in the drop down box to get to your "Make Payment For" page. Follow the directions on the page to either pay by credit card or send in a check.
- 9. When I go to kcskiclub.org to sign in, it automatically signs on to my spouse's account instead. How can I sign on as me? This happens when members share a computer and someone used the "Remember me on this computer" box when they signed in. It puts a cookie on the computer so that it always logs on to their account. Here are a couple of ways to get around this:

- a. For Google Chrome users: Click on the 3 black lines icon in the upper right corner of the screen. Click on "New Incognito Window". This opens up a new window in incognito mode it doesn't use or create cookies! In the new window, enter kcskiclub.org, and follow the instructions above to login to the website.
- b. For Internet Explorer users: Click on the gear icon in the upper right corner of the screen. Click on "Safety" in the drop down menu. Click on "In Private Browsing" in the next drop down menu. This opens up a new window that doesn't use or create cookies! In the new window, enter kcskiclub.org, and follow the instructions above to login to the website.
- 10. Why can't I sign up and pay for a trip for my spouse and children on the website? At this time each adult member will need to sign themselves up. Contact the trip captain to sign up junior members for a trip. Our website software vendor handles multi person memberships with one person set up as the Primary Member, additional adults set up as Secondary Members, and children set up as Junior Members. Membership dues for everyone on a membership are charged to the Primary Member. The Primary Member is financially responsible for everyone on their membership. The Primary Member can make trip payments for everyone on their membership. If you would like to change the Primary Member on your membership to you, email your request to membership@ kcskiclub.org, and please copy the current Primary Member on your membership.
- 11. Why am I'm not getting emails from KCSC? Check your profile to make sure we have your correct email address and make sure the box right below your email address is checked. If that checks out, your email provider may be sending KCSC emails to Spam. Check your Spam box for KCSC emails, move them to your Inbox, and add the sender email address to your contacts. Also, try adding the following domains to your list of approved domains: kcskiclub.org, clubexpress.com, and mail2.clubexpress.com
- 12. Can I put some of the pictures from our ski trip on the website? Email your pictures to photeditor@kcskiclub.org
- 13. We had so much fun on our trip. Can I share some of the stories from the trip on the website? Sure, write an article and email it to slushboomer@kcskiclub.org

PAYING FOR YOUR TRIP OR DEPOSIT OPTIONS:

- Enclose check(s), or money order(s) for the required deposit for each application enclosed. Make checks out to KCSC-name of trip, e.g., "KCSC Keystone 2." **DO NOT ENCLOSE CASH!**
- To pay by credit card. If you want to pay by credit card, just turn in the trip application in the KCSC mailbox and the trip captain will email you once he/she has registered you on the website. After receiving the email, you can pay for your trip deposit at www.kcskiclub.org with a credit or debit card by September 9, 2015.

I. TRIP PARTICIPATION ELIGIBILITY

- A. A. The Trip Captain has full authority to determine an individual's eligibility for a trip.
- B. An individual must be a member of the Kansas City Ski Club to sign up for a trip. Reciprocal FSA members may not sign up for trips until after October 8. (10/02) (10/13)
- C. An individual under age 21 is ineligible for an "adult trip" and he/she is eligible for other trips only if 1) he/she will be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian or 2) the Trip Captain grants permission, the parent/legal guardian provides a completed Minor's Travel Permit and Guardian Form, and the parent/legal guardian finds a willing adult trip participant to act as guardian. (03/03) (06/03)
- D. All individuals under age 21 (even if accompanied by parent/legal guardian) must have a completed Minor's Travel Permit and Guardian Form to be eligible for a trip. Minor release forms must be notarized and given to the Trip Captain with final payment. The parent/legal guardian and minor must each retain a copy of the form while on the trip. (06/03) (11/13)
- E. Children under age 5 are ineligible for any trip unless special permission is granted by the Trip Captain and the Trip Management Committee.
- F. Only individuals on the confirmed Trip List may occupy lodging space contracted by the Kansas City Ski Club. Violators will be subject to being charged the cost of the trip. (06/03)
- G. Pets are not allowed on any trip.

II. TRIP SIGN-UP

- A. Sign-up is accomplished by submitting to the Trip Captain a completed trip application and all scheduled payments due at that time.
- B. THE SIGN-UP EVENT IS OPEN TO ADULT MEMBERS ONLY. A member may sign up only for themselves and/or another member covered by his/her membership.
- C. Club Officers, Directors, Trip Captains, Committee Chairs, Past Presidents and others designated by the Trip Management Committee shall have early sign up privileges.
- D. Sign-ups will be recorded & maintained by Trip Captain in chronological order on one of the following lists:
 - 1. Confirmed Trip List: Eligible participants holding confirmed space on the trip.
 - Trip Wait List: Eligible participants who signed up after the Confirmed Trip List

 offered to persons on the Wait List in the order they were added to the Wait List.

III. TRIP PAYMENTS

A. Standard payments for all trips are:

A required deposit of a minimum of \$30.00 for bus or drive out trips or trip price, whichever is less – at least \$100.00 for air trips – due at time of sign-up. (06/05)(5/15)

- 1. An intermediate payment of 70% (rounded) of the balance (trip price less the required deposit) due at least 70 days or 10 weeks prior to trip departure. (07/05)
- 2. A final payment due at least 42 days or 6 weeks prior to trip departure.
- 3. Air trips may have more than two payments. (04/03)
- B. It is the trip participant's responsibility to meet payment deadlines. Failure to do so may result in cancellation from the trip. If payment is received late, the cancelled participant will be reinstated and placed at the end of the Trip Wait List. If the reinstated participant goes on the trip, the cancellation fee will be waived.
- C. Failure to replace an insufficient funds check, or rejected credit card payment in cash plus bank or credit card service charges within 3 days of his/her notification, will result in cancellation from the trip. (06/03) (04/14)
- Wait List participants are not required to make the 70- or 42- day payment prior to being offered a confirmed seat on the trip. (04/14)
- E. A KCSC member who is not a trip participant may purchase an activity ticket on Flatland and Kandahar trips. The ticket is all-inclusive, non-refundable, and will include an administrative fee.

IV. CANCELLATIONS

- A A person who has signed up for a trip and wishes to cancel must do so through written notification via email or postal service, to the appropriate Trip Captain. Cancellations received by the Trip Captain from a participant on the Wait List before the participant is offered space on the Confirmed Trip List will receive a full refund. The effective date of cancellation will be the date the Trip Captain receives the email or the postmarked date of the letter, whichever occurs first. (06/03) (04/14)
- B. Cancellations received on or after being offered space on the Confirmed Trip List are subject to a cancellation fee. Bus/non-air cancellation fee is \$30.00, per person, plus any trip liabil ities. (5/15) The cancellation fee for air trips is \$50.00, (or more if stated on the flyer) plus Any other trip liabilities. The Trip Management committee will determine the trip liabilities and notice will be given of any additional cancellation fee on the trip flyer. (06/03) (07/03) (04/14)
- C. Cancellations will be replaced by the Trip Captain from the Trip Wait List. If replacement cannot be made from the Trip Wait List, the person canceling may recruit their own replacement. The person canceling is responsible for notifying the Trip Captain when an eligible replacement has been found. This replacement will only be confirmed upon receipt, by the Trip Captain, of a signed trip application and any outstanding trip liabilities from the replacement. Families or couples on the Wait List may, at their option, allow another person on the Wait List to pass them and register for the confirmed Trip List. If there is no

(continued) other member on the wait list behind the group and the group chooses not to advance one or more of their party to the Confirmed Trip List they will be subject to any applicable cancellation fees. Replacement will not be effected until receipt of the trip application and all applicable payments due. (06/11) (07/11) (04/14)
 D. Participants on the confirmed Trip List who cancel or are cancelled by not making the
- D. Participants on the confirmed Trip List who cancel or are cancelled by not making the final payment deadline will forfeit the entire amount paid unless an eligible replacement has been effected. Participants canceling after the final payment deadline are subject to a cancellation fee even if an eligible replacement has been effected. (04/14)
- E. Military reservists or National Guard personnel who are called to active duty, or active duty military personnel transferred from the Kansas City area, will not be charged any cancellation fee to themselves, or their families. If canceling as a group, when an official copy of their military orders is received from their Commanding Officer. (07/04)

V. REFUNDS AND TRANSFERS

- All applicable refunds should be mailed within three weeks following trip completion. [06/19/03]
- Cancellation refunds will be for the amount paid less any appropriate cancellation fees and forfeitures.
- C. In the event mechanical or weather difficulties delay or prevent arrival at the destination, all refunds received by the Club for unused transportation, lodging or services in excess of actual Club expenses will be prorated to the trip participants by the Trip Management Committee.
- D. If a trip is cancelled by the Trip Management Committee, refunds will be made for the full amount paid by all participants who are on the Confirmed Trip or Trip Wait Lists.
- E. It is the responsibility of the trip participant to meet departure schedules and be responsible for materials provided by the Trip Captain. No refunds will be made for costs incurred for missed transportation or lost tickets. (04/14)
- F. Transfers: If a person cancels from a Wait List or if they cancel from a Confirmed spot on the trip and have been replaced, they may request a transfer of their refund to another trip by notifying the Trip Captain. (3/14)

VI. TRIP MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE AND TRIP CAPTAIN JURISDICTION

- A. The Trip Management Committee may cancel a trip if there are not enough confirmed participants.
- B. The Trip Management Committee may cancel a ski trip due to the lack of sufficient skiable snow. [06/19/03]
- The Trip Management Committee may cancel a non-ski trip if the planned activity is not available.
- D. Smoking on the bus by trip participants is prohibited. The illegal use of narcotics or other controlled substances will not be tolerated on any Ski Club sponsored trip.
- E. The Trip Captain is responsible for all decisions. Trip Participants will not take a vote. [06/19/03]
- F. If a participant is, in the judgment of the Trip Captain, jeopardizing the well-being of other trip participants, the Trip Captain may remove the individual from further trip participation such as, but not limited to, removal from the bus, and the individual(s) will forfeit all monies paid. [06/19/03]
- G. The Trip Management Committee may modify the standard trip payment or due dates for specific trips. Notice of such modifications will be published in the trip flyer, or written notification to trip participant. [07/22/03]
- H. The Trip Management Committee may change these regulations with approval of the The Board of Directors. Any changes will be published online in the club website. (04/14)

DEFINITIONS

- 1. TRIP An activity using Club-arranged lodging and/or commercial transportation.
- SKIING TRIP One which has snow skiing and/or snowboarding as the primary activity [03/02/03]
- NON-SKIING TRIP One which does not include snow skiing or snowboarding [06/19/03].
- TRIP FLYER A handbill used as the official advertisement for each ski trip. It includes all pertinent details, including the official trip payment schedule.
- ADULT TRIP Trip participants must all be 21 years of age or older.
- FAMILY TRIP Especially designed toward providing a trip cost & trip activities to accommodate family objectives (adults and juniors 5-20 years of age or older).
- MINIMUM OCCUPANCY The number of participants lodged in a particular housing unit; generally accepted as two per room in hotel accommodations and bedroom/loft occu pancy only in condominium units.
- MEDIUM OCCUPANCY The number of participants lodged in a housing unit; generally
- two per bedroom/loft plus one in the living room in condominiums.

 9. MAXIMUM OCCUPANCY The number of participants lodged in a housing unit; gener ally two per bed, plus two in the living room in condominiums. This can result in four to a room in a hotel or lodge. [06/19/03]
- FLY/DRIVE TRIP—Includes lodging and other trip activities. Trip does not include transportation.
- 11. PRIVATE BED Trip participant pays an additional fee to have a bed to themselves
